4.2 Programme learning outcomes

A minimum of 180 ECTS credits. Programme requirements as described in the Teaching and Examination Regulations, including a 60 ECTS credits propaedeutic phase, 30 ECTS credits study abroad and a 10 ECTS credits Bachelor's thesis.

The Bachelor's Honours Programme is an extracurricular programme to the regular Bachelor's degree programme. Students are admitted by means of a selection procedure. The Honours Programme is designed for talented, motivated, and ambitious students who want to get more out of their studies and who wish to challenge themselves by looking at scientific and societal issues from different fields in an open, academic, and interdisciplinary setting to further develop their disciplinary and interdisciplinary knowledge, talents, and skills.
